Project Description

This project will install approximately 0.5 miles of sidewalk along Route 3 between Heatherstone Drive and Bragg Road. Pedestrian crossings are also proposed for the signalized intersections at Heatherstone Drive, Taskforce Drive, and Bragg Road.

 - Pedestrian Access
 - Pedestrian Safety Improvement
 - UDA Multimodal Needs (Sidewalks, Pedestrian Infrastructure, Complete Streets)
- Benefits
 - Provides dedicated space for pedestrians separate from vehicular traffic.
 - · Provides pedestrian crossings at signalized intersections.
