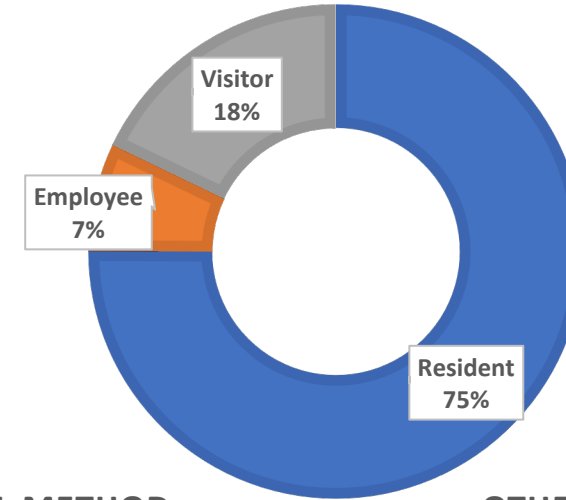

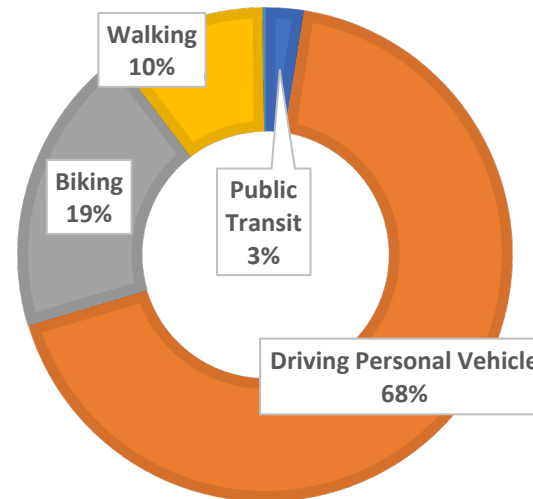
Survey Demographic Background

- There are 145 visits of the Spanish survey, but no responses were submitted.

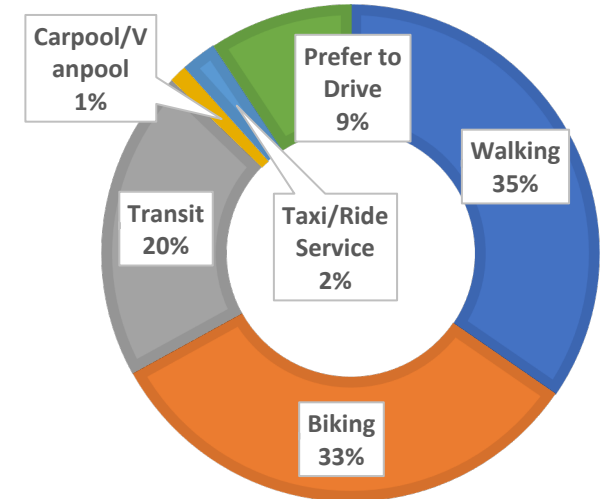

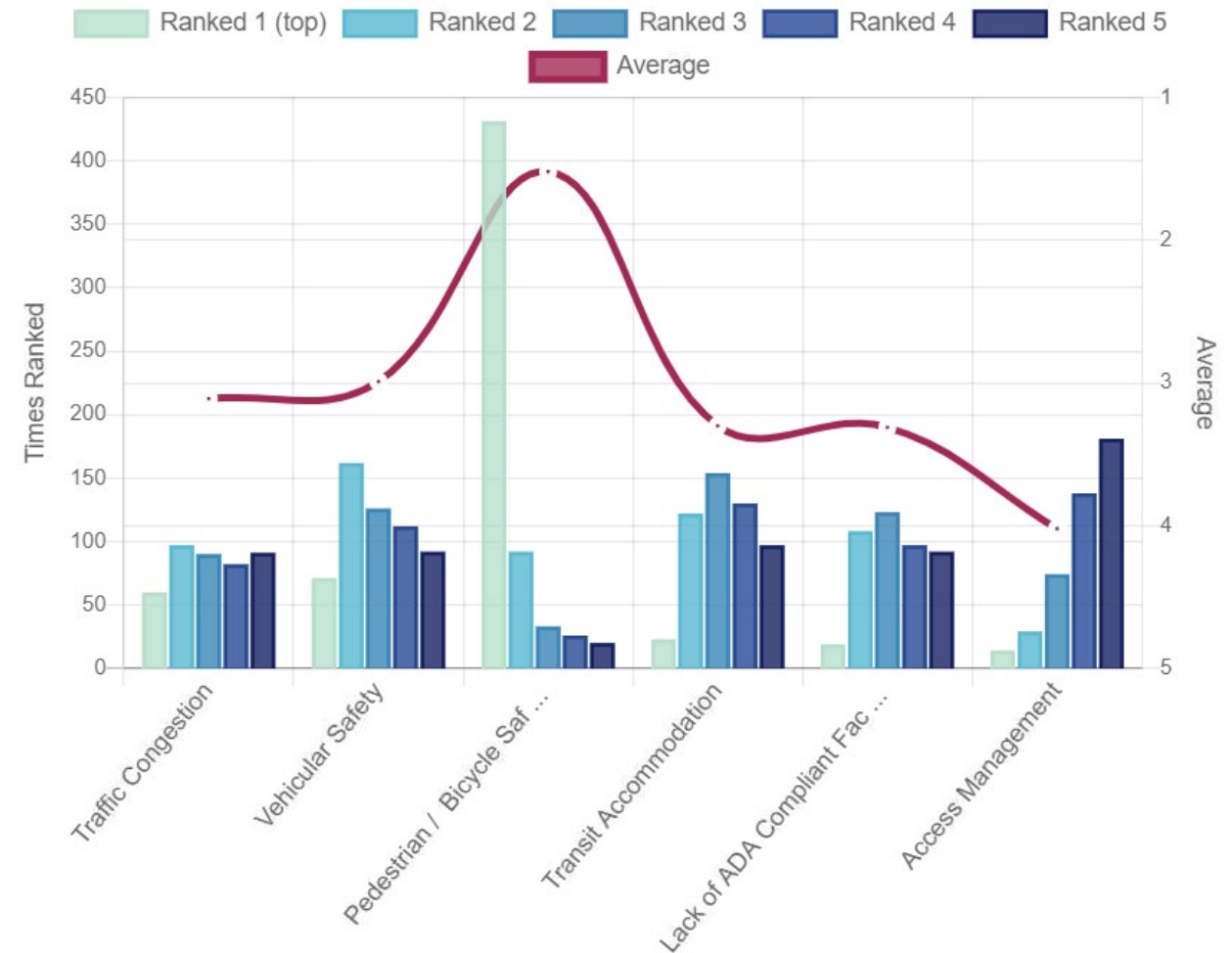

Ranking of Community Traffic Concern

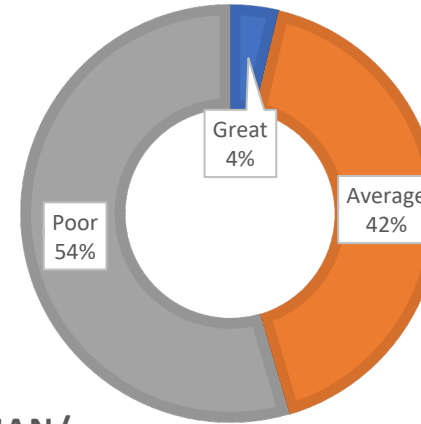
1. Pedestrian/Bicycle Safety

6. Access Management



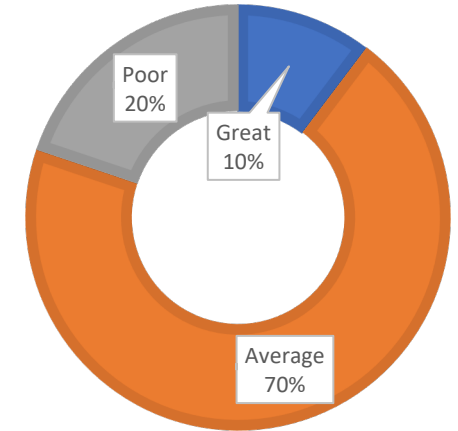
Existing Condition Rating

- Traffic Congestion and Access were rated as “Average”

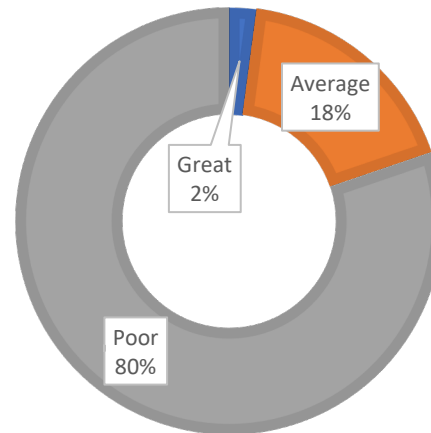

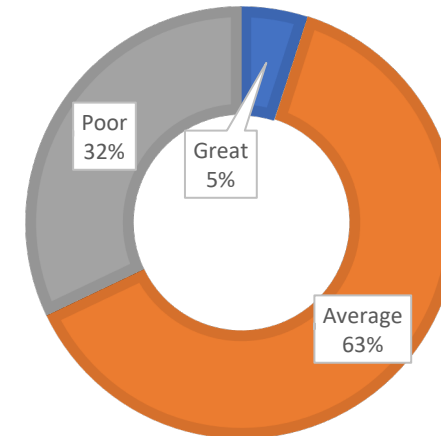
TRAFFIC CONGESTION



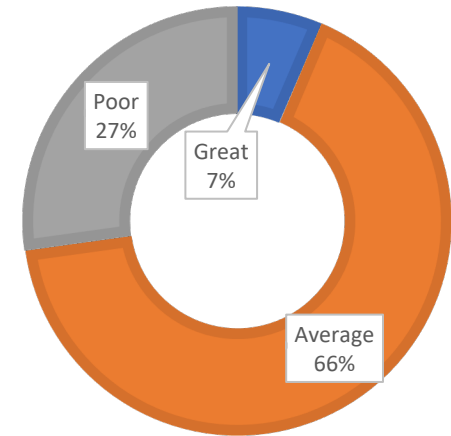

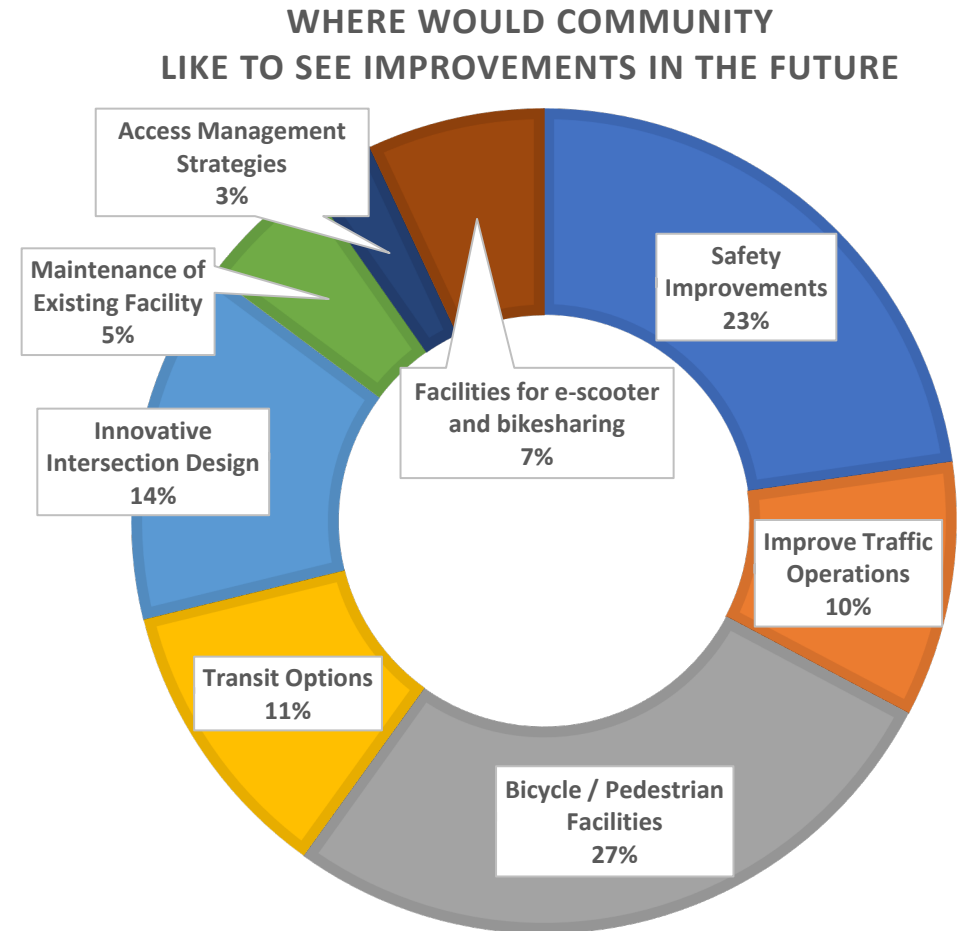

Future Investment Ranking

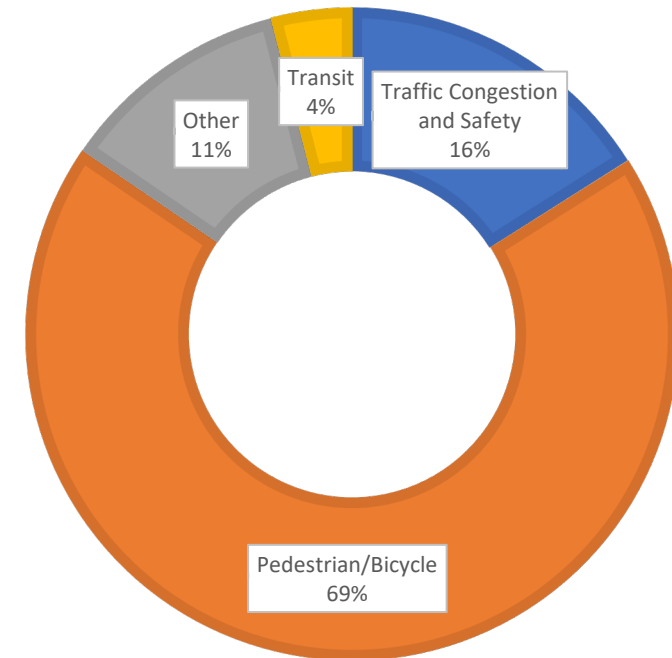
1. Bicycle / Pedestrian Facilities

Additional Comments of Future Change

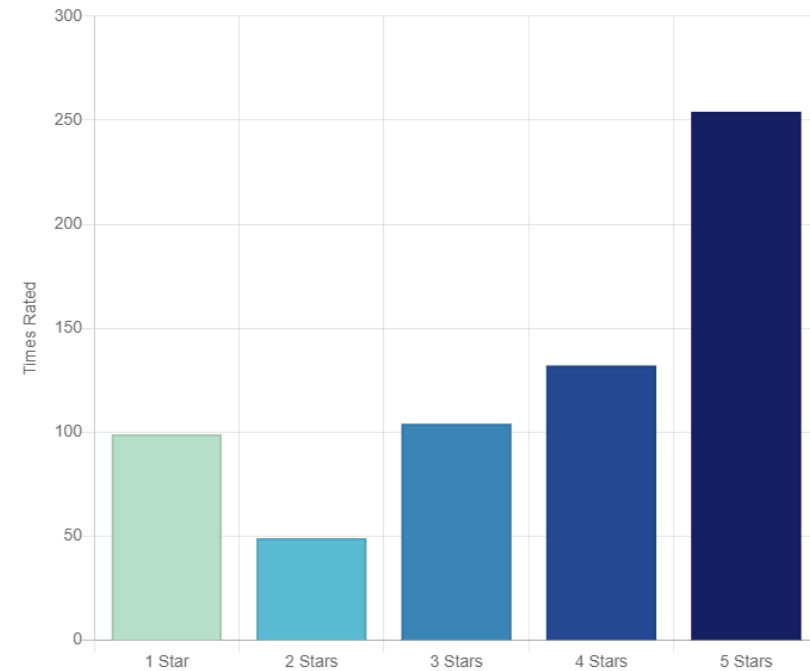
- Pedestrian/bicycle safety and accommodation are the public's biggest concern.

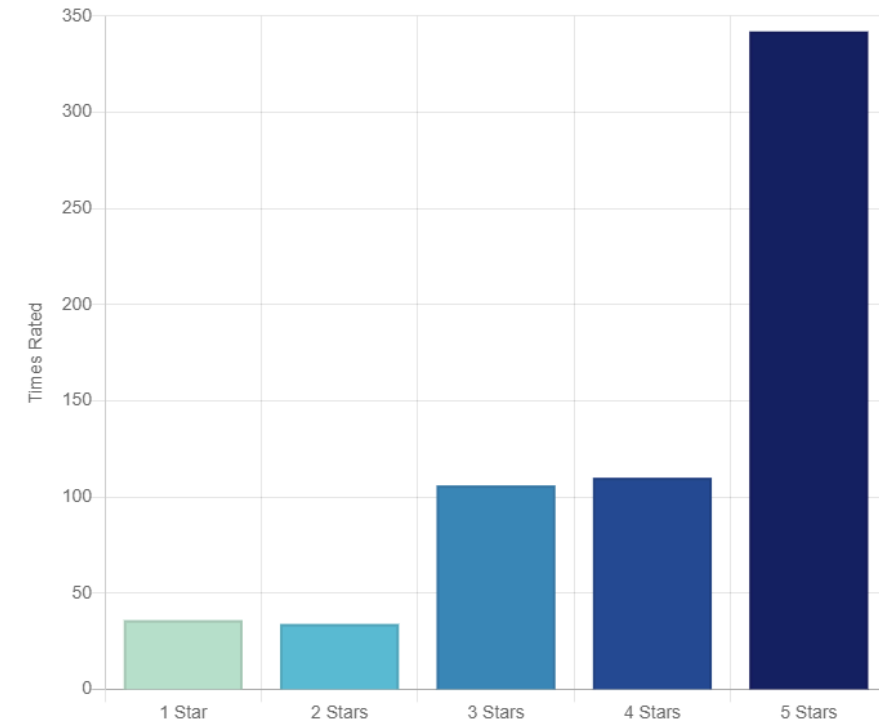
Improvement Option and Voting Result

— Route 60 at Forest Hill Avenue



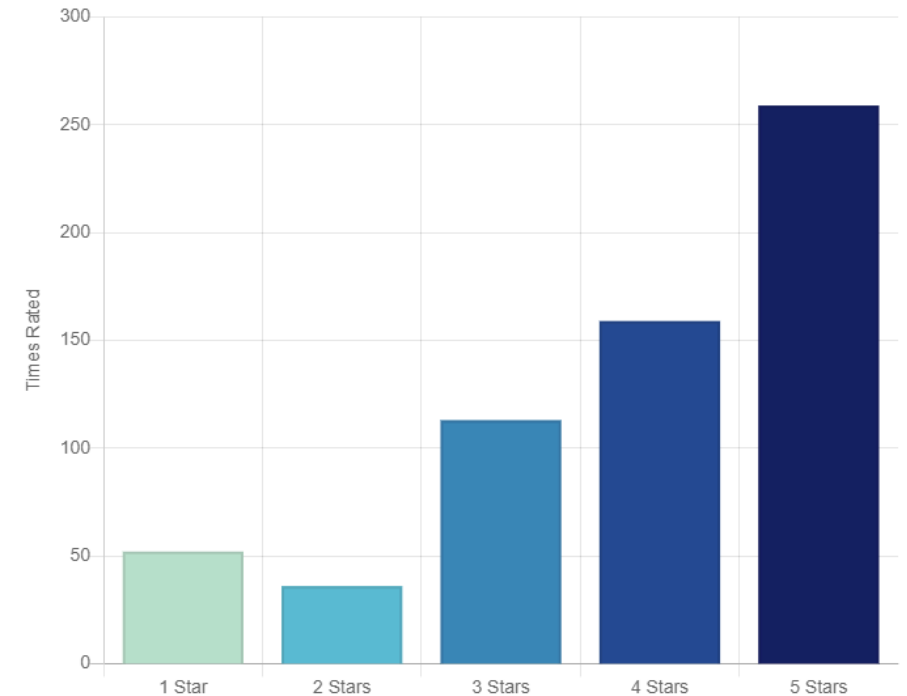
Improvement Option and Voting Result

— Route 60 at W 31st Street



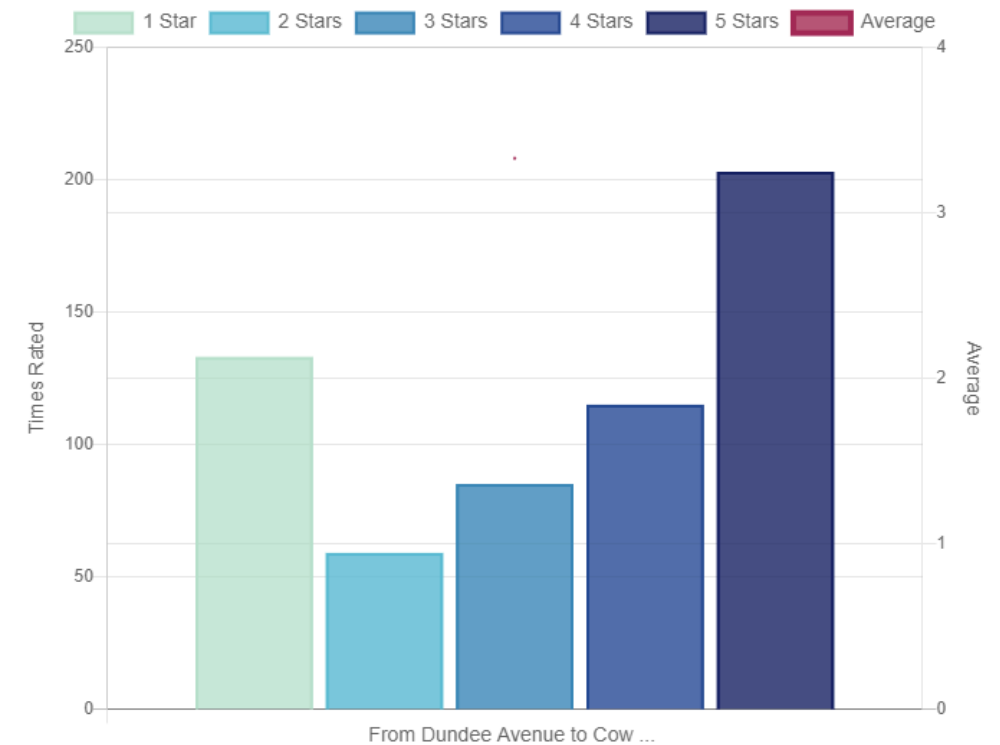
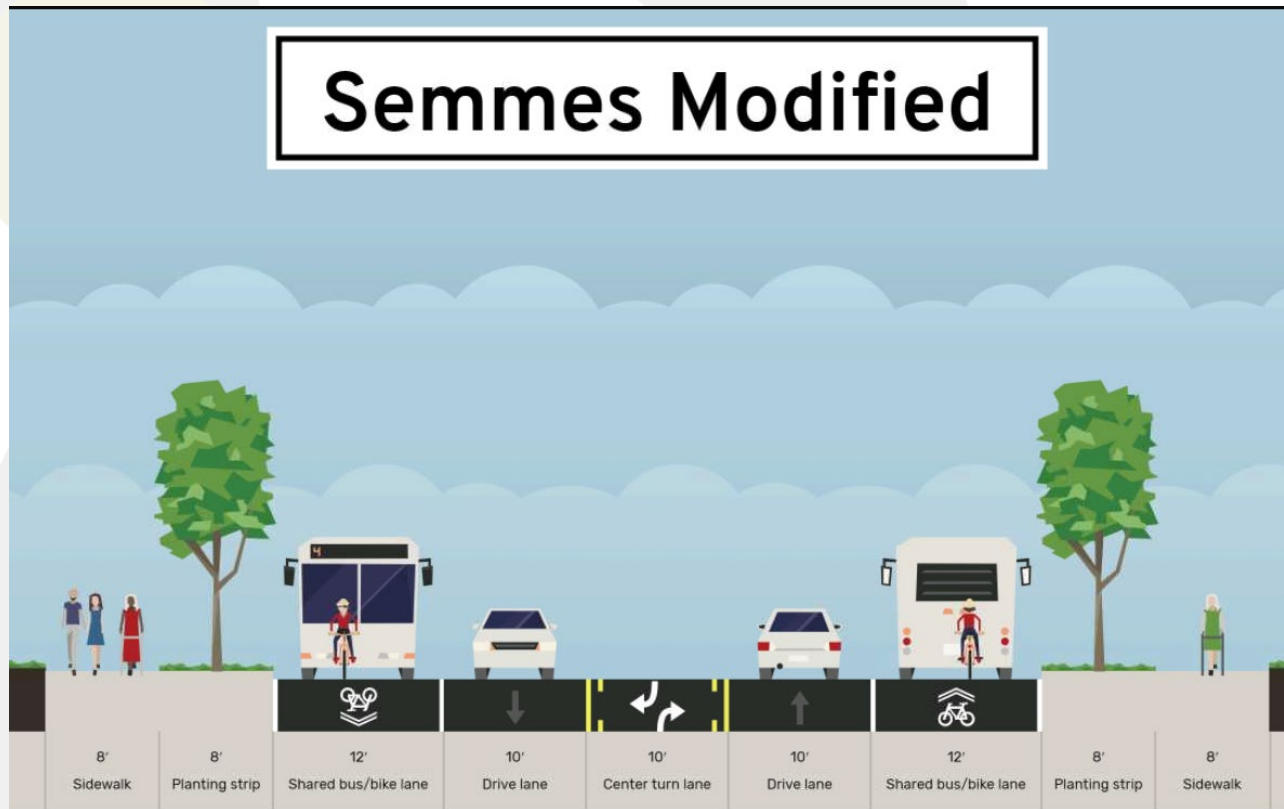
Improvement Option and Voting Result
